### Fees

Are to paid in full weekly, or if you wish to pay each half term up front you receive a 10% discount. This is to ensure and reserve your place at the Academy school. If you/your child does not attend for three consecutive weeks without notification, your place will automatically be withdrawn.

### **Carla Williams - Principal & Academy Dance Teacher/Choreographer**

Carla is widely known within the Entertainment industry, as one of the UK's most successful and accomplished Dancers and Choreographers. Her noteworthy credits include: Robbie Williams, Kylie Minogue, Terrovision, Morcheeba, Girls Aloud, Spice Girls, Rachel Stevens, Lonyo, Architechs, DJ luck and MC neat on top of the pops Ronan Keating Texas, Westlife Friday night with Johnathon Ross etc.

As a trained Actress, Dancer and Singer she has taken her talent world wide, working in Japan, Dubai, and headlining cruise ships as a singer dancer. She has also appeared in commercial work for big UK campaigns such as Cancer research ad. Carla has worked with the leading Pantomime Company SPILLERS as a resident assistant choreographer with roles such as fairy godmother in Snow White, Myrtle the Cockney Mermaid and eventually through consistent hard work she won a leading role as Peter Pan.

As a teacher in dance also at South Downs College the styles she incorporates into her work are street, urban dance, ballet, contemporary, Jazz, and dance performance. She taught at the famous Academy in London for four years teaching Dance to 4-18 yr olds . Her director then was Glen Murphy from London's Burning. This too is theatre school teaching three disciplines acting singing dance. The Academy of future stars prides itself on offering four as we include Tap dance and now break dance as an optional class.

She has also taught in various Stage Coach Theatre schools throughout the UK, including Farnham, Portsmouth, Kent, London/Essex.



My aim for the academy school is to offer a wide range of disciplines to the students in order for them to become versatile and adaptable with their skills. This will help them to become employable in the entertainment industry and give them future opportunities to follow their dreams.

### **John Paul McCrohon - Drama Teacher**

John-Paul teaches Drama both at South Downs College, where he has worked for four years and at The Academy of Future Stars.

As a professional actor /singer, John-Paul toured extensively across the country in productions including 'West End' to 'Broadway', 'The Jungle book' and 'Beauty and the Beast'. One off concerts saw him appearing at her Majesty's Theatre and the Royal Albert Hall in London, the latter appearing alongside the legendary Howard Keel in one of his last performances. TV appearances include 'Have I been her before?' For ITV 1 and 'The battle of the Atlantic' for BBC.

John Paul is well known locally for as the Artistic Director of multi award winning theatre company CCADS, providing area premiers of musicals and plays at venues including The new Theatre Royal , and The Kings Theatre and Third floor Arts Centre, also playing many leading roles for this and other noticeable companies.

## *Teachers at the Academy of Future Stars*

### **Louise Sevier - Vocal Coach**

I have been a musician for over 15 years and have played in various venues in the South including Wedgwood rooms and the Pyramids. My main instrument is Voice and I also play the keyboard and percussion. I hold a BA Honours in Music and I am also a qualified teacher with a P G C E.

I have been teaching at South Downs College for over 5 years. I also work with Music Fusion, who deliver workshop and get young people involved in music in the Hampshire area.

When vocal coaching I concentrate on vocal placement and correct breathing technique as this is a stage school students need to learn how to sing without damaging their voice and to be able to warm up and learn technical exercises. The styles I use are contemporary including Rock , Pop, Musical Theatre, soul and Funk etc.



### **Harriet Templer - Tiny Stars Teacher and Carla's Dance Assistant**

"I have been dancing for 10 years now participating in all styles of dance including tap, modern, ballet, disco and contemporary. At the age of 16 I started teaching 3-5 years olds and have continued to teach this age group ever since. I am professionally trained in contemporary dance and this is the style of dance I favour. I have appeared in various pantomime performances and have danced with various artists. I am currently at University doing a law degree but still love teaching dance.

Our Tiny Stars motto is "discipline fun in performance", All Tiny Stars automatically get offered a place in the Academy Theatre School once they reach five years old."

### **Michael Silk - Break Dance Teacher**

Michael has been a dancer for about three years breaking about 1 year with a huge history of dance and gymnastics allowing an explosive style of breaking. "In August last year I won the Udo world street dance championships coming first out of 700 people of my level 1 continue to teach and perform for many different acts such as JIS, Same Difference, Galaxy fm radio and others."
